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AREAS of EXTRA INJECTION RISK



6 Deep Danger Points

1. Supratrochlear &
2. Supraorbital notch
3. Infraorbital Foramen
4. Mental foramen
5. Mandibular groove
6. Deep temple vessels

Where vessels enter the face they are at the level of the bone, so never inject deep in these areas.



5 Arteries which run Parallel to Needles:

1. Superior & Inferior labial arteries when treating lips.
2. Dorsal Nasal Artery (rhinoplasty work)
3. Facial Artery (Nasolabial area)
4. Supratrochlear (frown lines)
5. Submental (jawline).

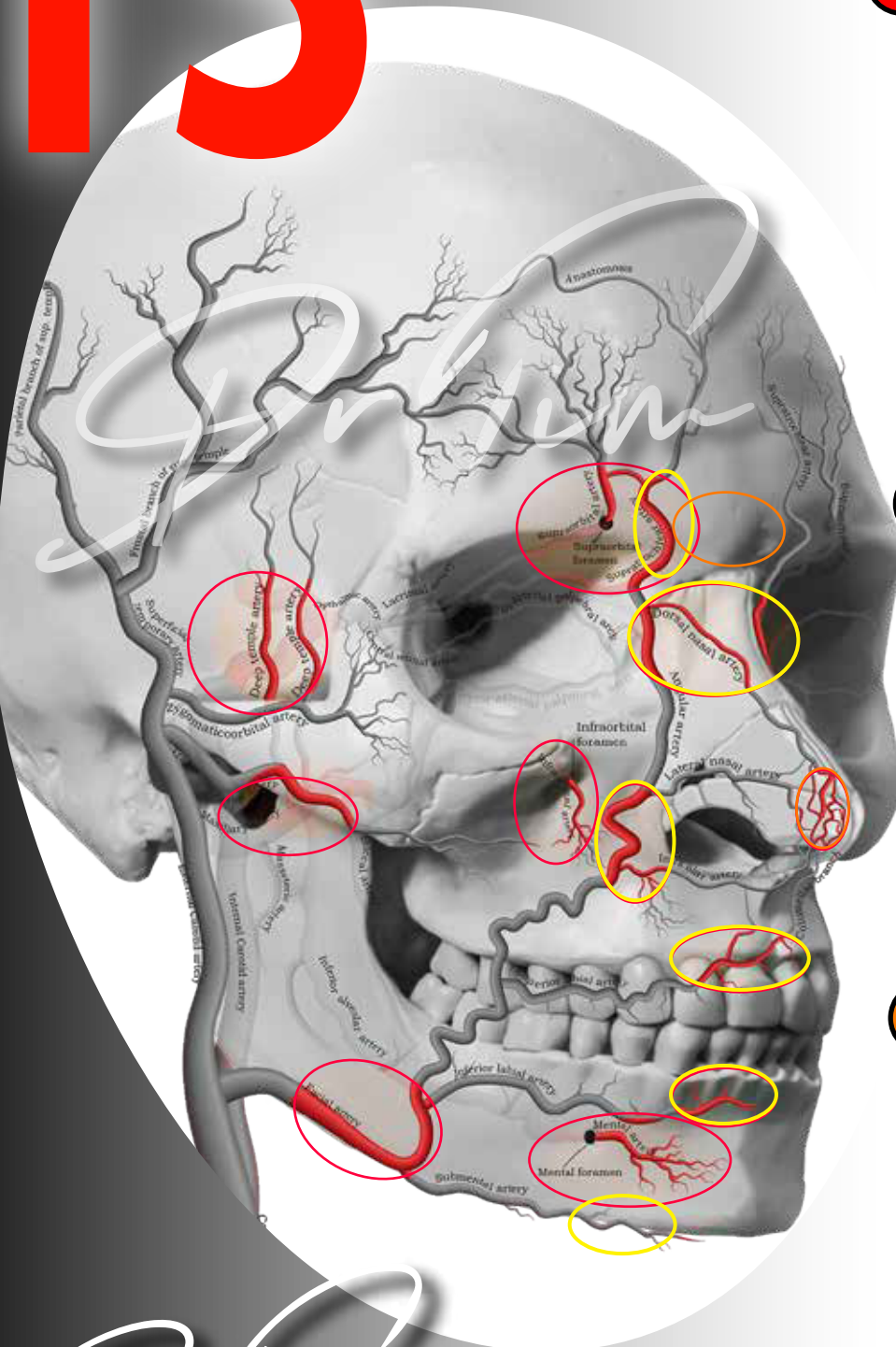
In these areas we must inject either too superficial or too deep for the vessels at risk.



2 Areas where Pressure may cause Capillary Compression Necrosis

1. Nose tip
2. Glabella area

The pattern of some areas of tissue necrosis appears not to follow the path of the artery, instead looking more like a pressure sore, one theory is this is caused by pressure rather than intravascular injection
